

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Registered with Oro Minor Hockey during the current season or the season immediately prior.
- **2.** Players and volunteers may apply; however, applicants must be eligible by age to have been registered as a player (current or prior season).
- **3.** Must be enrolled in or have been offered acceptance by a recognized Canadian post-secondary institution.
- **4.** Essay must be included (see registration form). The applicant also understands the essay may be featured on the Oro Minor Hockey website.

Application Requirements

The following documents must accompany the candidate's application

- **1.** A letter of introduction that provides the selection committee with details of the applicants Minor Hockey experience. The letter should include an outline of individual awards, volunteer activities and any other accomplishments directly related to hockey. Applicants are also encouraged to include volunteer or humanitarian activities that he/she has been involved in outside of hockey.
- **2.** Letters of reference from a coach/manager/administrator within Oro Minor Hockey and a teacher/administrator at their High School that is not involved in Minor Hockey.
- 3. Copies of their Grade 11 and available Grade 12 transcripts if in Grade 12.
- 4. Copies of their Grade 12 and first year post-secondary transcripts if not in Grade 12.
- **5.** A copy of their Offer of Admission from the Institution or confirmation of enrollment if available.

Oro Minor Hockey League must receive all forms by June 30, 2020. The committee's will render a decision on or before August 1, 2020.

The distribution of funds are contingent upon receipt of confirmation of the award winner's enrollment in the post-secondary institution.

The Oro Minor Hockey Bursary is funded by proceeds generated from the previous years' Golf Tournament. More than one candidate may receive funds.
